

WVBR All Star Eligibility & Assessments



Eligibility by Level

The following ages are eligible for All Star play by level:

- 1. 9U All Stars
 - A. All 9 year olds playing AAA
 - B. 9 year old players nominated by their coaches from AA
- 2. 10U All Stars
 - A. All 10 year olds playing Major Minor
 - B. 10 year old players nominated by their coaches from AAA
- 3. 11U All Stars
 - A. All 11 year olds playing Majors
 - B. All 10 Year olds playing Major Minor.
 - C. 11 year old players who play Major Minor, and do not have a Majors team associated to their area, may nominate up to four 11 year old players.
 - D. 11 year old players that play Major Minor, <u>and have a Majors team associated to</u> their area, will not be eligible for All Stars.
- 4. Major 70' All Stars
 - A. 12 year old players nominated by their coaches from Majors.

Note: For the 2015 season, any player that is not a full time participant in any of the divisions as they are listed above, will not be considered for All Stars.

Nominations

Nominations are based on a team's league standings at an established cutoff date as determined by the All Star Committee.

The Head Coaches will submit a list of names to the All Star Committee by a predetermined date.

Note: Nominations not received by the All Star Committee by the established cutoff date will disqualify any players from a specific team for All Star consideration. There will be no exceptions.

Assessments

Player attire: Players reporting for assessment will report in baseball attire that does not have an area logo on it. **Note:** <u>players showing up in area uniforms will be asked to remove the uniform/hat for their local area.</u>

Check in: Players are required to check in at their designated area both days at 4:30 PM. The player will be issued a number and then be sent to their designated field for assessment.

Missed Evaluations: Any player that misses either day of the All Star Assessments will be automatically disqualified from All Star Consideration. There will be no exceptions.

Player Scores: Players will be assessed in the following areas...

- 1. Hitting
- 2. Throwing
- 3. Fielding
- 4. Base Running
- 5. Knowledge of the game

Team Selection

Upon the conclusion of assessments, the coach's candidates (by level) will meet upstairs in the Complex Conference Room and go through the assessment scores. Each candidate will be required to select the top nine players (by score) on their respective rosters. The final three selections will be coach's picks based on what they feel their team needs are.

Note: No more than five (5) players may be selected from one area for any single All Star team.

Once completed, the prospective coaches will turn over their rosters to the All Star Committee.

Final Rosters

Final Rosters will be released on the Thursday immediately following the Assessments. At that time, the All Star Head Coaches can begin to contact their team's.
